- 1:1 support from a teaching assistant as required by a Statement of Special Educational Needs or an Education Health and Care Plan.

- Small group work planned by teachers to meet needs which arise through assessment.
- Assembly time support to help secure prior learning with class teachers and teaching assistants.

- In class support from a teaching assistant as required and planned by the teacher.
- Access to a range of resources to support inclusion in the classroom.
